MEADE COUNTY CLERK'S OFFICE CLOSURES TO PUBLIC ACCESS

In accordance with the order from Governor Beshear, the Meade County Clerk's office will be closed to the public beginning at 4:30 PM Tuesday, March 17, 2020 and will remain closed until further notice. This includes being closed on Saturdays. Our staff will continue to support mail, phone, and online transactions, and to prepare for the Primary election.

You have several ways to renew your vehicle registrations. First, online renewal is available for most vehicles at drive.ky.gov. Second, registration renewals may be mailed to us at the address above. Mail in renewals should include a copy of your registration receipt, proof of insurance, and payment. Third, we can renew your registrations over the phone at the number listed above.

Vehicle transfers will be suspended until further notice. Individuals that have purchased a vehicle from out of state will need to retain their documents until we can reopen. Individuals selling a Kentucky-titled vehicle to another person will also have to wait until we reopen to complete the transaction.

Marriage licenses will be issued by appointment only. Please call our office to schedule an appointment.

Passports will be done by appointment only and as long as the US Department of State allows for it.

Document recording may be submitted by mail to the address above.

Voters may continue to register to vote or update their addresses by submitting a new registration form online at www.govoteky.com until 4:00 PM on April 20, 2020. Registrations by mail must be postmarked by April 20th.

Voters who qualify to vote absentee by mail may call our office to request an application.

Notary oath and bonding are suspended until further notice.
